

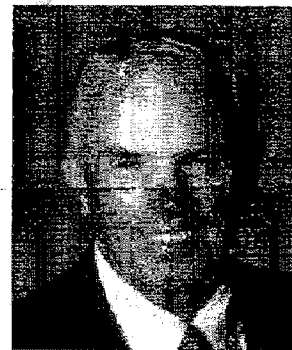

# PAC Begins Rollins Theater Fix-Up

**SCC Resident Arlene Oakley Gives \$30,000.  
 Greater Sun City Center Foundation Grants \$25,000.**

A pre-renovation renovation program is underway in the Rollins Theater and, to paraphrase Al Jolson, "you ain't seen nuthin' yet." With the CA's plans to completely reconstruct the Rollins delayed for several years because of a fall-off in real estate transfer fee money, the PAC volunteered to spend "all we have" to make the Rollins look like a theater, feel like a theater and operate like a theater.



## Improvements So Far

~ The Rollins' walls and ceiling have been painted.

~ Automated stage curtains are in place; a new black velour main curtain and a special effects scrim.

~ New ceiling spotlights have been hung and new stage lights installed.

~ The main entrance has a canopy. New double doors and a ticket booth will be installed.

~ A new sound system is in place.

~ A producer's booth has been constructed at the rear of the theater.

~ New ceiling fans with lights have been mounted.

~ Custom window drapery has replaced the vertical blinds.

~ More comfortable seating has been arranged. Upholstered chairs

will become available as new seating is acquired for Community Hall.

~ Backstage dressing rooms are being redesigned and refurbished.

~ The stage's hardwood floor will be refinished.

~ New flooring will be installed in the auditorium, after dance and exercise clubs take up residence in new facilities.

These improvements are being accomplished through generous contributions of:

\$30,000 from Sun City Center resident **Arlene Oakley,**

\$25,000 from the **Greater Sun City Center Foundation,**

and proceeds from more than three years of \$10 ticket sales to residents of Sun City Center and surrounding communities.
